1. About the Mwihur Theatre Festival:

It is widely believed that the first dramatic stories were probably told by primitive tribe who would return from the hunt and re-enact the events for the rest of the tribe. The term drama derived from Greek word for deed or Act earliest origin of drama are also to be found in Athens where ancient hymns, called dithyrambs were sung in honor of the god Dionysus.

The native known to be earliest settler of Brahmaputra River valley practiced hunting and gathering throughout their advancement of civilization of their life and livelihood. Their literature, culture art, history, knowledge, custom etc all evolved through folk tradition. The native especially the Bodos inherited a rich folk tradition of narrating tragedy and comedy around the fire site at the onset of winter performing kherai through different dance forms at the altar of Bathou (indigenous faith or religion) for thousands of years is one of the earliest known dramatic performances of the community. Endless tales and legends including Sandw Baodia, Gwhwshrwn, Embushrwn, etc are evidence of the rich repository of dramatic wealth amongst the local native. Similarly, in the earlier times people of bodo community also used the hunting for their livelihood and in Bodo language is called 'Mwihur'. The word Mwihur is comes from grandfather and great grandfather because in earlier times people used hunting to survive. According to Bhaben Narzi book, Bodo Kacharini Somaj Arw Harimu, "People of Bodo, Kachari Community used to hunt pig and deer meat from the forest to eat with rice". From this we come to know that the word Mwihur is a very important for the Bodo tribe.

Taking cue from the genesis of drama Lwrgi Theatre Group has decided to organize the first international drama festival with the title of a Mwihur a Bodo word hunting. The Bodos until recently used hunting and gathering as means of living amidst the vast and lust greenery on the foothills of Himalaya, forest, river, lakes and all kinds of natural resources were in abundance. This help the community to live sustainably amidst the nature and nurture their art, culture, customs and tradition.

However in the past independent India, Bodos and other native had to struggle for their survival and existence. Their ethnic and culture identity were at stake. They put up a very brave resistance an shed their bloods that resulted in protracted conflict.

1. About the organizer of Mwihur Theatre Festival:

From the beginning Mwihur International Theatre Festival has been organized by Lwrgi Theatre Group, Chandamari, Kokrajhar and supported by Government of Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR), Assam. The group was established on 10th May, 2009 vide Registration No KJR/253/L/106 of 2009 dated, 9th July, 2009 under the Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860 with a firm objective to promoting, propagation and preservation of culture heritage in the country at large and promotion and enhance the Theatre movement in the country in particular. Since its inception the group has been running actively and working seriously under the guidance of Sanjib Kr. Brahma who is very dedicated theatre activist in the region.

In every year the group has been organizing residential—non residential workshops, seminar, different types cultural activities, Social Awareness programmes on different themes etc. In every year LTG produced new play productions. Along with dramatic activities the group is working on Folk Music & Dance also. The group has been participated in several National and International Drama & Cultural Festivals organized by the Ministry of Culture, GoI and other Govt. & Non Govt. organizations in different part of the Country.

The main objective of the group is to articulate talent both physically and mentally. So that the youth & children can pay attention on cultural activities even in an unstable social condition in the entire North East India. Keeping in view the objective of the group we have been organizing workshop both for adult and children inviting expert faculties from all over India.

The Mwihur International Theatre Festival (The1st International Theatre Festival of Bodoland) was organized by the Lwrgi Theatre Group and supported by the Department of Cinema & Theatre, Govt. of Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR) at Bodofa Cultural Complex, Kokrajhar. The event had been held from 28th January to 3rd February, 2023.
